**Mr. Hugh Poulin (Parliamentary Secretary to Solicitor General):** Nil. However, inmates transferred to medium and minimum institutions from a Regional Reception Centre or a maximum institution are always medically screened. Should an inmate be in need of psychiatric treatment while in a medium or minimum setting, he would either be seen as an out-patient by a visiting psychiatrist or, if his condition were serious, be transferred to an institution that provides such treatment. Inmates who are receiving psychiatric treatment on a full-time basis are detained at one of the three Regional Psychiatric Centres operated by the Canadian Penitentiary Service or, in some instances, receive treatment in provincial hospitals.
