The memorial of Peter Du Calvet,

Humbly Sheweth,

THAT your memorialist has been settled
in the province of Quebeck, formerly
called Canada, ever since the year 1758, and
that, some time after the peace in 1763, he
sold his patrimonial estate in the South of
France, in order to carry over the produce
thereof into the said province, and enjoy the
benefits of the British Government, as it was
then established by the King's proclamation
of October, 1763, and the commission to
Governour Murray made in pursuance of
it;---That he executed the office of a Justice
of Peace in the said province with the fairest
reputation and the entire approbation of the
governours of the province, from the year
1766, to the year 1775;---That he has al-
