TABLE OF APOTHECARIES' WEIGHT

Table as given in *British Pharmacopœia*.

437½ Grains.....	make 1 Ounce.
16 Ounces	1 Pound.

The grain is the same as the grain Troy; the ounce is the same as the ounce Avoirdupois.

APOTHECARIES' FLUID MEASURE.

In this measure, founded on the fact that a pint of pure water weighs 20 ounces:

60 Minims.....	make 1 Fluid Drachm..fl. dr.
8 Fluid Drachms	1 Fluid Ounce...fl. oz.
20 Fluid Ounces.....	1 Pinto; octavius.
8 Pints.....	1 Gallonc; congius.

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
