in the old law-books, vehere the wickednefs of the act is aggravated by the circumftances of fecrecy, or treachery, murder has been long fince fettled, to be the voluntary killing a perfon, of malice prepenfe; though certainly that which is either fecrer, or treacherous, in proportion as it becomes lefs eafy to elude, and more difficult of detection, is, in its nature, infinitely more alarming and odious.

For this reafon, of all modes the moft deteftable is poifon; and the murder of perfons ftanding in particular relations of confidence to the murderer, takes a higher caft oí guilt, and is denominated petit-treafon.

Thefe fpecific aggravations do not, that I know of, exilt in any cafe that is likely to come before you: But if any thing like them exifts, thefe ferve beft for illuftration.

What the particular circumftances may be, from which it fhall be propofed to you to frame a charge of this offence, againft any perfons now in cuftody, as far as they have come to my knowledge, I leave to be collected by you from the witneffes, and forbear to anticipate ; betaking myfelf rather, to what is more peculiarly the povince of the Court in this ftage of the proceedings, i. $e_{\text {. }}$ to give you a fhort direction, upon what principle you will do well to govern yourfelves, as refpecting the evidence that fhall be laid before you, in turning it into a Bill.

That you come to this enquiry with no paffions but a defire of public juftice, nor with any worfe fentirnent than that of an honeft indignation, at a fuppofed offence, of the deepeft dye, I am fo convinced, that I have not a word to fay but in commendation of the motives, by which I believe you to be actuated, upon the prefent occafion.

Permit me oniy to entreat you, not to let that indignation, which, as applied to the crime, is laudable, tranfport you too far, againft any who may be innocent of it.

At the fame time, if you have ground for a probable opinion, that Murder has been committed, it is that crying offence, that will not Reep, but will have inquifition made of it in open day.

In this cafe, lefs than direct and full evidence will be fufficient
