

QUEENSTOWN, May 24.—The Cork steamer Inniscara, bound from Fishguard to Cork, has been torpedoed and sunk.

Thirty-seven members of the crew are missing and are supposed to have been lost.

Five members of the vessel, the captain, chief officer, one steward and two sailors, have been landed.

The Inniscara was struck amidships. She listed immediately and foundered in five minutes.
