STEAMBOAT CONNECTIONS.

TORONTO.—Daily with Royal Mail Line Steamers, for Kingston, Montreal and Quebec, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays, with Steamers "ARMENIA" and "CUBA," for Kingston, Brockville, Prescott, Ogdensburg, Boston, and all points in Eastern States. Daily with Steamer "CHICORA," for Niagara, Lewiston, Niagara Falls and Buffalo; and Steamer "PICTON" for Port Dalhousie and St. Catharines.

HAMILTON.—Daily with Royal Mail Line, for Montreal, Quebec and intermediate points.

PORT DOVER.—Mondays and Fridays, at 10 a.m., with Steamer "ANNIE CRAIG," for Port Rowan.

GRAVENHURST (Muskoka Wharf).—Steamers "NIPISSING" and "WENONAH" daily, at 1.40 p.m., for Bracebridge, Port Carling, Windermere and Kosseau, and intermediate points. Tuesdays and Saturdays, at 7 a.m., for Bala and intermediate points. Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, at 7.20 a.m., for the Rosseau Falls. Mondays and Wednesdays, at 2.30, for Port Cockburn.

BRACEBRIDGE.—Stages daily, at 3.15 p.m., for Port Sidney; thence Steamer "NORTHERN" for Huntsville, Hoodstown and intermediate places. Semi-Weekly, Tuesdays and Saturdays, at 8 a.m., for Baysville; thence Steamer "HELENA" for Dwight, Dorset and other places on the Lake of Bays.

ROSSEAU.—Stages daily for Parry Sound. Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays for Magnetawan; thence on Tuesdays and Fridays to Lake Nipissing. The new Steamer "INTER-OCEAN" will shortly be making regular trips upon Lake Nipissing.
