On the 18th of this month the Sun enters the constellation of Pisces, properly a fish with scales, being the last of the twelve signs of the Zodiac. Minerva placed this constellation in the heavens to commemorate the escape of Venus and Cupid from the giant Typhon.—They were one day sitting on the bank of the Euphrates, and seeing the giant approach, they threw themselves into the sea and became fishes, and so escaped.

The planet Venus will be the Evening Star until July 26,—after that period she will be the Morning Star to the end of the year.

This month will set in with variable weather. Occasional heavy falls of snow, succeeded by severe frosts, will be the distinguishing features of the weather until the 19th, when, at 8 minutes after 6 o'clock in the evening a change will take place, when softer breezes with showers of rain may be expected.
