5th. Subscribers to a certain amount have the privilege of purchasing the books and tracts at the Repository at a reduced rate.

6th. Every Subscriber has the privilege of sending a poor child to the school, to which pay-scholars

are also admissible.

7th. Connected with the Department of this Institution, which relates to Education, is the School-clothing Fund, an object peculiarly entitled in this climate, to the public benevolence.
