ECLIPSES FOR THE YEAR 1892.

During this year there will be four eclipses,—two of the Sun, and two of the Moon.

I. April 26th, there will be a total Eclipse of the Sun, invisible here.

Begins on the Earth generally, April 26th 7h. 46m. in mean time at Greenwich in Longitude 148° 35' W. of Greenwich and in Latitude 75° 59' S.

Central Eclipse ends generally April 26th 10 h. 42 m. in Longitude 81° 53' W. of Greenwich and Latitude 36° 54' S.

II. May 11th, there will be a partial Eclipse of the Moon, visible Halifax.

First contact with the Penumbra May 11 3h. 41mo.

Middle of the Eclipse..... " " 4h. 56mo.

Last contact with the Penumbra... " " 9h. 36mo.

III. October 20th, there will be a partial Eclipse of the Sun, invisible here.

Begins on the earth generally, October 26th, 4h. 15m. mean time at Greenwich in Longitude 133° 22' west of Greenwich, and Latitude 65° 25' N.

Greatest Eclipse, October 26th, in Longitude 33° 9' W. of Greenwich and Latitude 61° 33' N.

Ends on the earth generally, October 20th, 8h. 57m. in Longitude 50° 52' W. of Greenwich, and in Latitude 14° 2' N.

IV November 3 and 4 there will be a total Eclipse of the Moon, partly visible here as a partial Eclipse Halifax.

First contact with the Penumbra.....Nov. 3rd, 8 57 ev.

Beginning of total phase..... " 11 9 ev.

End of Total Phase..... " 11 53 ev.

Last contact with the Penumbra..... " 4th, 2 4 mo.
