#### UNITED STATES HAS DRIED UP, SAYS HAYNES

Give Figures Showing Less Than One Per Cent. of Pre-War Consumption.

Washington, May 30.—How the United States has "dried up" under prohibition, despite rum running and bootlegging, was the subject of a statistical statement Monday by Federal Prohibition Commissioner Haynes.

His figures showed 1,050,833 gallons of spirits exported from the United States to Canada in 1918, before prohibition, against 818,106 gallons last year. The Canadian imports for this year show a reduction of about fifty per cent. from the 1918 rate, he added. United Kingdom imports to the West Indies and Bahamas show an increase from 84,140 gallons in 1918 to 350,311 gallons for the first four months of this year, or at an annual rate of 1,050,833 gallons.

"If the entire amount was smuggled into the United States," said Commissioner Haynes, "it would equal less than three-fourths of one per cent. of the tax-paid liquor withdrawals for consumption in the United States for the fiscal year 1918, which amounted to 140,294,644 gallons."
