### BRAIN'S ARMY OF UNEMPLOYED

London, June 5.—The Ministry of Labor states that 10,000,000 receipts for unemployment have been sorted and checked from Nov. 28 last up to the end of March and the work is still in progress. The mere classification of the army of demobilized men according to occupation and the reserving of these forms under the names of some 27,000 towns and villages around employment exchanges is no light task, some 150,000 of all kinds of workers, being dispatched each day. The alphabetical index, consisting of leaf registers, is of great aid in the present pressure of work. In this department figures are transferred to special cards, by holes punched in certain positions, by holes cards are sorted by machines into groups as required. These groups of cards are then passed through a machine which prints the details from each card on to a roll of paper, at the same time accumulating the figures and producing a total at any given point.
