THIS INSTITUTION A SCHOOL FOR BRIDES

English Girls Taught How to Keep Their Husbands Happy

(London Standard)

The problem of how to be happy married—a problem which has become more difficult to solve since Mr. Lloyd George added to the worries of the wife—has been bravely dealt with by a school for prospective brides in Westminster. This establishment is not officially known as the school for brides, its formal title is the "St. Martha's College for Housewives." But it is attended by so many young women who are contemplating matrimony that it has fairly earned the more picturesque description. A number of engaged girls are always preparing for the marriage state there, some going on their own initiative, while others, it is hinted, are induced to take lessons by the young men who have an eye to the future.

This college of housewife, which is under the patronage of the Catholic Archbishop of Westminster, the Dowager Duchess of Newcastle, the Marchioness of Bute and many other distinguished people, is designed to help those who cannot obtain a thorough knowledge of housework at home. A full course of lessons lasts for six months, during which time the student may live in the house and learn the management of the household, the steps to supervising servants. A short series of lessons is given, but it is only the complete course that earns the college certificate, and, presumably, fully qualifies the prospective wife or housekeeper.

A visit to the college shows that the instruction given is both practical and theoretical. Here, under expert supervision, bright-eyed young women are doing all the work of the house, from bread-making and butter-making to the washing of clothes and the ironing of linen. They are taught the art of cooking, the art of cleaning, the art of managing servants, the art of making a good dinner, the art of making a good bed, the art of making a good fire, the art of making a good house.

There is no question of trying to do the husband's work, but of doing the wife's work. The students are taught to do the work of the house, to do the work of the kitchen, to do the work of the laundry, to do the work of the garden, to do the work of the stable, to do the work of the carriage, to do the work of the house.

Daily Hints For the Cook

BUCKWHEAT JOHNNY CAKE.

One cup buckwheat flour, 1/2 cup bread flour, 2 teaspoons cream tartar, 1 teaspoon soda, 1 1/2 cups sweet milk. Mix all ingredients well, add a tablespoon melted butter. Beat thoroughly and bake in a hot oven.

"WHOLE" SOUR MILK CAKE.

One cup butter, 2 cups sugar, 3 cups sour milk with 2 teaspoons soda dissolved in it, 5 cups sifted flour, 1 cup chopped and seeded raisins, 13 teaspoon salt, and 1/2 a nutmeg. This makes 2 loaves. By the addition of cloves, allspice and cassia to taste you can have a dark cake.

SUGAR SLIP.

Take two cups of brown sugar and one of white sugar and one cup of water. Boil five minutes, lay a piece of lemon peel on each long on top while boiling. It will not taste of the peel. Or you can add a little of it to a few drops of lemon extract.

WELLBLESSED FUDGE CAKE.

One and a half cups sugar, half cup butter, well creamed, three eggs, one cup milk, two and a half cups pastry flour, one teaspoon cream of tartar, half teaspoon soda, salt, and a half square of chocolate, half cup walnut meats (English walnuts).

Fudge frosting: one and a half cups confectioners' sugar, half square chocolate, one and a half tablespoons butter, quarter cup of milk, pinch of salt, half teaspoon vanilla. Cook three minutes.

TELLS STORY OF THE ELOPMENT OF MRS. SNEAD AND BOYCE

Fort Worth, Tex., Feb. 13.—With 600 pairs of eyes focused upon him and amid a silence interrupted only by the ticking of a clock, the story of how Albert G. Boyce, Jr., and Mrs. Lena Sned eloped from Fort Worth on November 9, thereby setting in motion a chain of tragic events that has cost one man's life, driven another into exile and placed another on trial for life, was told for the first time by Ed. Farwell, a friend of Albert Boyce, Farwell, who is cashier of the Dillard Bank, owned by the Boyces, testified at the trial of J. B. Sned, on trial for murder of Captain Boyce, having been called by the defense.
