Q-143 But you think it is much harder with a person of his make-up who feels when he wants to get away to stay put in any one place?

A- Yes.

---THE DEFENDING OFFICER: Sir, would you ask Major Lawson that considering that he thinks McKinnon is responsible, would he agree that McKinnon's actions, for instance, are the things that he would expect, even though he is responsible. The question is maybe not clear. He thinks that McKinnon's brain is clear and he is responsible for his actions. But are his actions the type of actions he would expect from a person like McKinnon?
