Limewater also is satisfactory for preserving eggs and is slightly less exspensive than waterplass. A solution is made by placing 2 or 3 pounds of unslaked lime in 5 gallons of water which has been boiled and allowed to cool, and allowing the mixture to stand until the lime settles and the liquid is clear. The eggs should be placed in a clean carthenware jar or other suitable vessal and covered to a feet of 2 inches with the liquid. Remove the eggs as desired, rinse, in clean, cold water, and use immediately.
