POSTAL INFORMATION.

The rates of Postage within the Dominion are-

For Letters, 3 cents per half oz., each.

For Newspapers (transient) one cent per 4 ounces; posted singly, one half ct. each, if under one ounce.

For Books, Pamphlets, Circulars, &c., &c., 1 ct. per 4 ounces; the packet to be open at both ends, for inspection.

For Parcels, exempt from inspection, 6 cts. per 4 ounces.

Pre-payment of the above, by affixing stamps, is required.

REGISTRATION.—To make transmission more secure, Letters may be registered upon pre-payment of 2 cents, each, and parcels 5 cts, each.

Post Cards are issued from all Post Offices at one cent each.

Money Order Office in the Province:—For sums not exceeding \$4, two cents; not exceeding \$10, five cents; not exceeding \$20, ten cents; not exceeding \$40, twenty cents, &c., &c.
