An Act to amend the Act to indemnify Members of the Legislative Assembly for their expenses in attending the Sessions of the Legislature.

HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act passed in the twelfth Prenmble. year of Her Majesty's reign, intituled An Act to indemnify the 12 V. c. 33. Members of the Legislative Assembly for their expenses in attending the Sessions of the Legislature, and further to lunit the amount of 5 indemnity to be allowed under the said Act in certain cases; Therefore Her Majesty, &c. enacts as follows:

I. For and notwithstanding anything in the said Act to the contrary:

No Member of the Legislative Assembly, having his ordinary resi- Allowance to dence out of Session at the place where any Session of the Provincial members residing at the Declinary is half shall be estimated to make the place where the solutions for each siding at the 10 Parliament is held, shall be entitled to more than ten shillings for each Seat of Govday's attendance during such Session.

No Member of the Legislative Assembly shall be entitled to the Total allow-allowance mentioned in the said Act, or in this Act, for more than one ance limited. hundred days in any one Session of the Provincial Parliament.

II. It shall not be lawful for the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly, Clerk not to or for any officer thereof, to pay to any Member thereof, under any pay more under or Resolution of the said Legislative Assembly or of any Comlution or ormittee, or other authority, any further or greater sum as indemnity or der. allowance than the amount allowed by the said Act as hereby amended, 10 and the allowance for travelling expenses granted by the said Act.

III. This Act shall apply to the present Session of the Provincial Act to apply Parliament.
