An Act to amend the Act to indemnify Members of the Legislative Assembly for their expenses in attending the Sessions of the Legislature.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's reign, intituled *An Act to indemnify the Members of the Legislative Assembly for their expenses in attending the Sessions of the Legislature*, and further to limit the amount of indemnity to be allowed under the said Act in certain cases; Therefore Her Majesty, &c. enacts as follows:

Preamble.

I. For and notwithstanding anything in the said Act to the contrary:

No Member of the Legislative Assembly, having his ordinary residence out of Session at the place where any Session of the Provincial Parliament is held, shall be entitled to more than ten shillings for each day's attendance during such Session.

Allowance to members residing at the Seat of Government.

No Member of the Legislative Assembly shall be entitled to the allowance mentioned in the said Act, or in this Act, for more than one hundred days in any one Session of the Provincial Parliament.

Total allowance limited.

II. It shall not be lawful for the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly, or for any officer thereof, to pay to any Member thereof, under any Order or Resolution of the said Legislative Assembly or of any Committee, or other authority, any further or greater sum as indemnity or allowance than the amount allowed by the said Act as hereby amended, and the allowance for travelling expenses granted by the said Act.

Clerk not to pay more under any resolution or order.

III. This Act shall apply to the present Session of the Provincial Parliament.
