The UNB Student Representative Council and the University administration is exploring possibility of acquiring a "liquor" license for this campus.

A license of this type means that those group individuals who wish for a liquor would go to an individual campus to get their liquor occasion permits, instead applying directly to the Licensing Board Prospect Street. The New Brunswick Licensing Board is encouraging action of this sort. It will meet paperwork on their part. Presumably, they are allocated only a certain amount for secretarial help yet the volume of work is huge. Should the board issue a university a "blanket" license volume of work on their behalf would be considerably less.

In the case of UNB, approximately 360 licenses were issued.
