General Order.

The Commander of the Forces has had under His consideration the Report of a Board of Officers of which Brigadier General Vincent was President, assembled by His Excellency's Order at the Head Quarters of the Eastern Division of the Army, on the 20th July 1813 for the purpose of considering the Claims of the Indian Warriors in regard to Head Money for Prisoners of War brought in by them, and to the propriety of some provision being made for those who may be disabled on Service.

With a view to soften and restrain the Indian Warriors in their conduct towards such Americans as may be made by them Prisoners of War His Excellency is pleased to approve of the following arrangement submitted by that Board, and directs that the same may be acted upon.
