

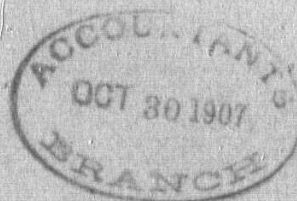

Memorandum for  
Deputy Minister.



In Sept., last, application was made to the Department for the erection of a stable and fence at the new R.C. church at Cape Croker.

The Indian agent was requested to have a careful estimate made of the cost and submit the matter to the Indian Council.

The agent now sends specifications of the ~~church~~ <sup>Stable and</sup> a resolution from the band recommending that three hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$325.00) be loaned the Roman Catholics of the band for this purpose.

Two of the Indian Councillors, Chas. Jones and Peter Taylor, have offered to erect the stable, furnish all the material and complete the same for \$250.00. These men are strongly recommended by the Agent.

This would leave \$75.00 available for the fence.

I beg to recommend that an O.C., be applied for giving authority for the expenditure of \$325.00 of band funds for this purpose.
