Dear Sir,—

I have your letter of the 19th, inst, re road across the corner of reserve between the Priddis trail and south boundary.

I am not in a position to say anything to Mr Calder, I said you were to see what you could do with the Alberta Government through him, and then have a petition signed to be forwarded to the Department of Indian Affairs asking them to get the Indians to surrender sufficient land for the purpose of making a road to be surveyed and fenced, and that I would recommend same to the Department.

If they agreed, I would do my utmost to get Indians to surrender, but you understand I cannot do anything without authority.

I would advise you get your petition endorsed strongly by our Member Mr. R. B. Bennett.
