

Montreal 21<sup>st</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1818

Sir,

I have the honor to transmit herewith the Pay and Pension Lists for Montreal and Quebec, and an abstract of Disbursements from the 25<sup>th</sup> of October to the 24<sup>th</sup> of December 1818, together with the Requisitions for the Annual Presents for the several Indian Villages, and an Estimate of Presents that may be required for the Indians of this District and for visiting Indians. —

All the Returns were not sent in till the close of the Navigation. They must now be forwarded by land, if His Grace the Commander of the Forces Approves of them. —
