

FOURTH WITNESS FOR THE PROSECUTION

B 44508 Gnr. Antler, W.E., having been duly sworn states:-

I am B 44508 Gnr. Antler, W.E., HQ 2 Cdn AGRA.

QUESTIONS BY THE PROSECUTOR

Q. What are your duties in the HQ?

A. I am a DR for the orderly room.

Q. Will you give us in a very few words what happened on 27th October 44?

A. I had just returned from a run to 2 Corps and I was having my supper in the kitchen when Sgt. Walker, Bdr. Robertson, and Gnr. Jones came in. I asked Jones what had happened and he said that he had been in an accident and the water truck and trailer were on the highway. So then, I told them where an AWD was from there where they could take the veh. Before we started Sgt. Walker asked me where Foster was and I told him I might know, so we stopped in the centre of Eccloo and went to this place to see if Foster was there and he wasn't. We proceeded to the AWD and got a tow truck, and I went back with the tow truck to pick up the wrecked veh and after that I went back to the AWD with the wrecked veh as an escort and then returned to the HQ.

QUESTIONED BY THE DEFENDING OFFR

Q. Did you see Foster during the evening?

A. At 5 or 6 o'clock.

Q. Did you see Foster after 1800 hrs?

A. No sir.

QUESTIONED BY THE COURT

Q. Did you see Gnr. Foster during the afternoon?

A. No, since I was away.
