

LETTER OF TRANSMITTAL

OTTAWA, July 15, 1907.

To the Honourable
The Minister of Agriculture.

SIR,—I have the honour to submit Bulletin No. 90, Dairy and Cold Storage Commissioner's Series, entitled 'The Use of Ice on the Farm.' A great waste of valuable food products occurs every year on the farms of Canada owing to lack of a simple means of preservation within reach of every farmer at a very small cost. A supply of ice, while preventing loss of perishable articles, adds very much to the comfort of the farmer's household in hot weather. This bulletin is intended to encourage the practice of providing a supply of ice for the needs of the household and the dairy, and to furnish information to those who may not have had any experience in the storing and handling of ice.
