

Which motions shall have precedence in the order herein arranged.

No officer or member shall be entitled to vote at any meeting on any subject which concerns himself, or in which he may be personally interested.

The Chairman shall be entitled to vote as a member, and have a casting vote in case of equality.

The Chairman may prevent any member from speaking more than once on the same motion until all other members have had an opportunity to express their opinions.

The ruling of the chair on any point of order shall be final.

There can be no suspension of the rules, except by a two-thirds majority of the members on the roll of the Club.

The chair shall be taken by the senior officer present, or, if all are absent, by a gentleman chosen from among the members assembled.

The Chairman shall not take part in any discussion without first resigning the chair.
