Canadians can thus at any time refer their friends or correspondants in \*England to the Mercury, for reliable records of local events during recent or remote years; and it shall be our endeavor always to make it as full and authentic a diary in the future as it is admitted to have been during the past. Complete files of this paper are also among the archives of the Parliament of the Dominion of Canada, at Ottawa, and that of the Provincial Legislature in this City.
