"THE MERCURY" FILES—We have had the satisfaction of receiving, by this day's English mail, intimation that the file of the *Quebec Mercury*, bound in yearly volumes from its foundation by T. Cary, senior, barrister, first editor and proprietor, in January 1805, (and grandfather of the present editor and proprietor,) has been received complete and in good order at the library of the British Museum in London, where it will be preserved with all the other historical works open to the British public in that valued and venerable institution. Canadians can thus at any time refer their friends or correspondants in England to the *Mercury*, for reliable records of local events during recent or remote years; and it shall be our endeavor always to make it as full and authentic a diary in the future as it is admitted to have been during the past. Complete files of this paper are also among the archives of the Parliament of the Dominion of Canada, at Ottawa, and that of the Provincial Legislature in this City.
