

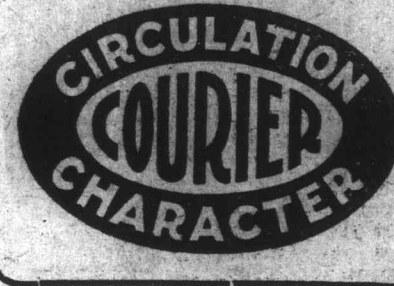

UNBROKEN HORSES

Eight Hundred of Them Caused a Big Time

Associated Press. Bombay, April 10.—Eight hundred unbroken horses ran wild recently in a paddock at the Byaulia Racing Club here, smashed down the fences and spread all over Bombay, causing considerable panic in the native quarters, and dislocating railway and street traffic for the entire day.

Large numbers of the animals got onto the railway lines, where several of them were killed. Six of them fell into a large sewage culvert. Horsemen from the race track spent the whole day and the following night in pursuit of the animals. Only 460 horses were finally recovered, the remainder having either been killed or escaped into the countryside.

Only one man was seriously injured in the Bazaar district by being trampled by a herd, while in a main street a motor car was wrecked by the horses rushing madly over it.

NEW GERMAN WAR BOOTS

Are Clumsy and Will Only Last a Short While

Associated Press. Amsterdam, April 10.—The new German war boots and shoes which have recently been on display at a public exhibition in Berlin, are thus described by Vorwarts: "Heavy clumsy boots, made out of all sorts of substitute materials with paper uppers and wooden soles several centimeters in thickness, the weight and bulk of them is increased by huge nails and protectors with which they are studded. The price for these monstrosities is enormous. It takes to replace, each pair of durable leather boots could be purchased at about 12 marks, this war-footwear for children costs 17 marks, for women 22 marks, and for men 24 marks."

"Moreover the purchaser is warned that the soles of the war boots will only last seven or eight weeks. As each wooden sole costs from 5 to 6 marks to replace, each pair of men's boots will cost the wearer at least 40 marks every six months. Whether the paper will keep out the cold and wet is more than doubtful."

TELEGRAPH OPERATORS.

By Courier. Lensed Wire. Peking, Thursday, April 4.—(By the Associated Press)—The Germans are recruiting and training telegraph operators in Manchuria, according to a report made today to the War Ministry by the general staff. These operators are being trained specially by the Germans as wire tappers. The recruits also include wireless experts. It is believed there are wireless stations hidden in Mongolia and Manchuria.
