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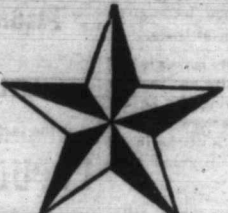

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World's Fair Notes.
Many relics of the Cabot, the early English voyager to America, will be exhibited at the Exposition by a committee formed for that purpose in Bristol, England, where the Cabots lived.

During the last few years—the last two or three years especially—I have had frequent, and most free and intimate conversations with the late Cardinal upon what I called the social question—upon those questions which touch the misery and wretchedness which seem to be the property of so many millions in modern society.

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
