Risks Breaking Neck Performing For His King.

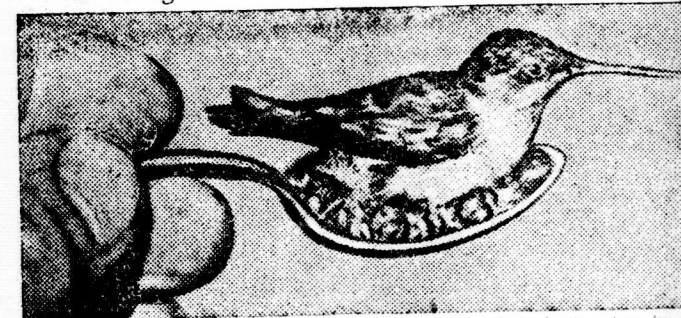


ONE of the daredevil equestrians of the Bulgarian army rode his horse down a 10-foot descent, defying death, while King Boris and the royal family watched him.

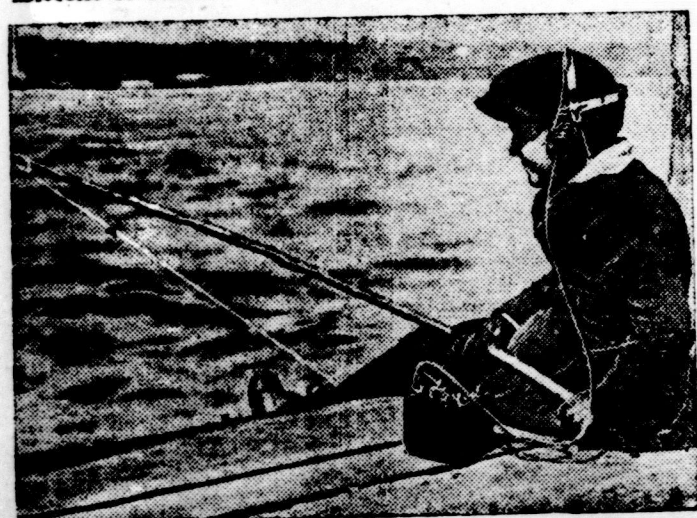
