MANY VALUABLE HORSES CREMATED

Seven Valuable Animals Burned Near Patterson, K.C.—Fired and Saved.
Batter's String Lost Destroyed.

New York, Dec. 30.—Early this morning the racing stables belonging to V. Hallock, situated on the Damous Drive, between Clifton and Patterson, N.J., were destroyed by fire and 10 valuable animals were burned. The names of the horses are: Buddha, St. Patrick, Monopoli, imported Graham, Glen Island, Vanale, Vocalist, Laura F., Gley by Tremont out of Helian; imported Monthair and imported Freedom.

A despatch from Lexington says: Batter's stables near here were burned early this morning. Twelve fine horses perished, including the celebrated Partisan, owned by President Edwards of the W. U. T. C. Co. Gen. Eckardt lost two other valuable horses. Total loss \$120,000.

New York, Dec. 30.—Albert Schock, the old-time Chicago rider, won the six-day bicycle race at Madison-square garden, which closed to-night. Although the men had ridden hard all day all of them began to bathe themselves in sweat as the evening advanced. Schock wanted to cover 1600 miles, Martin wanted to reach his record made in 1891, while the others desired to get above the 1400 mile mark in order to get the \$100 guaranteed to men covering that distance.

The score at the finish at 10 o'clock was: Schock 1600 miles 3 laps, Waller 1484 miles 7 laps, Martin 1430 miles 1 lap, Albert 1410 miles 1 lap, Van Emmeren 1401 miles 1 lap, Golden 1313 miles 1 lap, Meixell 1190 miles, Forster 1045 miles, Barton 1006 miles 3 laps, Hammer 909 miles, Ashinger 878 miles 3 laps.

Schock covered the 1000th mile at 9:50 o'clock, and the 1400th at 11:00. He beat all previous records by 143 3/5 miles.

MARTIAL LAW IN DUVAL COUNTY.

Governor Mitchell Expected to Make this Declaration When the Time is Right—Corbett is Favorite.

JACKSONVILLE, Fla., Dec. 30.—Pugilistic circles are still worried over the attitude of Governor Mitchell. His telegram to county officers here, charging or intimating collision, has provoked great comment, and the officials have replied in a very peppy manner. The Governor is expected soon, and those who favor the contest will exert every pressure to have him keep quiet. Able lawyers here say that if the Circuit Court decides in favor of the match the Governor cannot interfere. The habeas corpus proceedings will be heard on Wednesday instead of Monday.

The change of the fight from 9 p.m. to some hour between 11 a.m. and 1 p.m. is good only as the vast crowd expected to be in attendance will be better handled.

Sherriff Broward expects to have direct orders from the Governor at any time. He and those who know the Governor say the orders will be strict and not at all obscure.

A prominent sporting man who stands close to Governor Mitchell said to a press representative to-day: "The Governor has announced that he has a trump card to play and that he will stop the fight. BARNARDO'S EMIGRANTS.

An English Paper Defends the Doctor's Scheme for Settling Poor Boys in Canada.

[From the Newcastle Chronicle.]
The work in which Dr. Barnardo is engaged should have fair play. Statistics demonstrate that he has done much to rescue the children of the gutter from the ruin that might otherwise overtake them. It is not indeed pretended that there have been no failures among those that were hoped had been reformed. We cannot expect perfection in even the most judiciously managed institutions. But Dr. Barnardo's homes come as near perfection as human nature permits. Those who stigmatize his work as a failure in the matter may not have the same distrust of the Canadian minister on whose authority it is stated that "less than two per cent. of all Dr. Barnardo's young emigrants are failures, and only a fraction of one per cent. has been added to the criminal population of Canada." It is not worth the trouble to place beyond controversy the facts that the doctor has accomplished his work. But a section of the people of Canada is daily too anxious to find his benevolent efforts in vain. We should not, however, be misled by the original account, which the houses have to contend with.
