Satin is not to be superseded by Ottoman silk or velvet for at least another season. Among the richest dresses yet exhibited are those of plain satin with several yards richly embroidered with velvet of gay colors in bunches of flowers.

Black Russian lambekin is the fur that will be most used for trimming cloth dresses and cloaks. Spanish peleries of this glossy waving fur will be worn accompanied by small fuff muffs with square corners.
