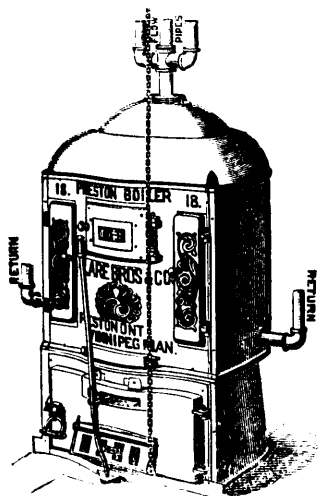




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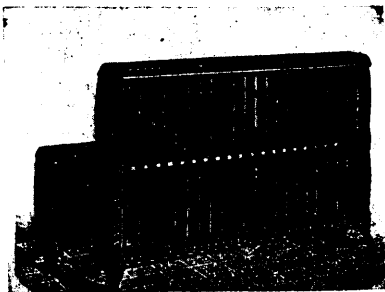

The construction is simple, being complete in one casting. There are no joints requiring bolts, and, as an economical house warmer, it stands in the front rank.

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
