



ANNEX III

Under these Rules and Regulations, the interests belonging to enemy nationals are considered as enemy interests.

enemy countries are:

Germany within its boundaries as of December 31, 1937, and within its boundaries as of December 8, 1941 (exclusively of territory occupied by its military forces).

enemy nationals:

those citizens of one of the two above-mentioned countries who are in either in enemy territory or in a neutral country or in allied territory when in the latter case their property has not been placed under custody or has been released from custody, are considered as enemy nationals.

change in nationality:

German nationals who have acquired another nationality after September 8, 1939, are considered as enemy nationals unless they have acquired the nationality of an allied country before January 1, 1918, or have had their permanent residence in that country.

Special cases:

Foreign persons of German origin may not be considered as German nationals if the German Government had deprived them of this status before October 1, 1938.
