

**ARRANGEMENT
BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA
AND
THE EUROPEAN SPACE AGENCY
CONCERNING THE PARTICIPATION
BY THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA IN THE EUROPEAN
PROGRAMME FOR LIFE AND PHYSICAL SCIENCES
AND APPLICATIONS IN SPACE**

THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA (hereinafter referred to as “Canada”)

and

THE EUROPEAN SPACE AGENCY, established by the Convention opened for signature in Paris on 30 May 1975 (hereinafter referred to as “the Agency”),

HAVING REGARD to the *Cooperation Agreement between the European Space Agency and the Government of Canada*, done at Paris on 15 December 2010 (hereinafter referred to as the “Cooperation Agreement”), and in particular its Article III;

HAVING REGARD to the Resolution on the European Programme for Life and Physical Sciences and Applications Utilising the International Space Station (ISS), referenced under ESA/C/CLI/Res. 4 (Final), adopted by the Agency’s Council on 21 June 2001;

HAVING REGARD to the Declaration on the European Programme for Life and Physical Sciences and Applications in Space (hereinafter referred to as “ELIPS”), referred to as ESA/PB-MG/LXX/Dec.1, rev. 5 (Final), as amended on 6 December 2005;

HAVING REGARD to Canada’s request to participate in the ELIPS Programme expressed at the meeting of the Agency’s Council held at ministerial level on 5 and 6 December 2005;

HAVING REGARD to Article XIV.2 of the Agency’s Convention, which relates to cooperation and participation by non-member States in the Agency’s programmes;

HAVE AGREED as follows:
