My dear Dudley:-

The League of Nations has completed a regular organization of the Society in Montreal with Mr. P. E. Corbett as Secretary-Treasurer.

According to the constitution of the League of Nations Society in Canada 25% of the money collected by any Branch is retained by the Branch, while the other 75% goes to the Headquarters of the Society in Ottawa.
