to his own Houfe, where I continu'd twelve Days to refresh my felf. He forbid all his Servants to give me any thing to eat, left I shou'd fall fick, if left to my own Discretion, after fuch long Hardships, and gave me himself what he thought best; when I defired his Permiffion to go to Quebec, he appointed two of his Guards, who underftood very well to manage a Canoe, to carry me thither from whence, foon after, I return'd to Eu-rope. 15.18 11 11 11 11
