HUNT RACES IN SCARBORO.

There will be no Hunt Club races this autumn at the Woodbine. This was decided at a meeting of the committee yesterday, the manager, in the opinion of the committee. Instead of a day of steeplechasing and gymkhana events will be given on Saturday, Oct. 25, and on the following day.

The success of Holcher in the Brighton Cup on Saturday brings into the public eye not only Willie Holcher but his brother John. These two young men have played important parts in racing for the last two years, and since the latter is now deprived of his license as a trainer, it is the opinion of many racers around New York that he was made to do so because of his success.

A group of turfmen were gathered together talking horse at Belmont Park when the names of John and Willie Holcher were brought up. The suspicion of the latter's license was recalled. Every man said he thought the Jockey Club stewards were harsh in their treatment of the young trainer and wondered why he had made the mistake of going to Belmont. Some said when the other men who had handled the horse and described him as a good one, he permitted to go to Belmont without even so much as a reprimand.

"You don't imagine that was the real reason why John was suspended, do you?" asked a man who has made a living out of racing for a great number of years and is familiar with every angle of the game. "Don't be so foolish," said the other. "He was looking for a chance to even up his score against the Shields family ever since Willie sold him Oaklawn for \$20,000. Belmont bought Oaklawn in good faith and thought he was purchasing a fine two-year-old last season. He was disappointed to learn that he was buying a horse that was a representative in the Special and for that reason gave the big man that Willie asked for his coat. He expected the youngster to race well, well, was mortified to see him show so much speed as a price for the horse. He was in the race. That performance of Oaklawn's but Mr. Belmont's price was a mistake. The fact that many of his friends were present did not aid to his joy. Subsequently he was told that the horse was the same of his retirement, and when he was slightly referred to Oaklawn as the dearest of his son's, he must have waxed warm."

"Willie, who by the by, thought he was selling a first-class horse to Belmont and was innocent of any attempt to pass over to Belmont the horse which he had secured and therefore escaped the wrath of Belmont. But when John, his well-to-do brother, came to Belmont as chairman of the Jockey Club, his license was revoked. Why were the trainers who had previously looked after Belmont's stud immune from punishment while John had the chance to make a livelihood out of his race? It is a question which the steward wished to see an example? Yes! Well if it was, I think Belmont was a little hard on him. This was this that horses in the future must not sell poor horses to August Belmont. I don't think Belmont was punished because Willie sold Oaklawn to Belmont, a horse worth as many cents as his new owner paid dollars for."

Main Chance was heavily backed to win the fifth race for 2-year-olds at Belmont on Monday, but disappointed his followers, as he was never able to take a controlling place in the running. There were six starters, with Pallander the opening favorite at 2 to 5 and Main Chance at 10 to 1. The heavy play, however, was all for Main Chance, who went to the post at 10 to 5, while the odds against Pallander lengthened to 2 to 1. While on form Atkin and Admo must have been given a chance to win, there was no evidence of strong support for them, as each went to the post with a heavy handicap. Atkin looked like having a winning chance, away from the post well enough, he was outstripped by the leader, and was a step in the final furlong.

Marty Bergen, a veteran jockey, who rode many famous horses in his time, died on Sunday after an attack of pneumonia.

YANA CHRISTY AT BELMONT WINS THE STEEPCHASE

Belle of Pequest First Thru Mud in Fairview Stakes—Summaries, Entries, Selections.

New York, Oct. 9.—On a muddy track, Belle of Pequest, the 4-to-3 favorite, scored an easy victory in the Fairview Steep Chase, 1 1/8 miles, at Belmont Park today. Leonard Joe Hayman led by two lengths to the stretch, where the favorite took command and won by five lengths. The storm which broke just after the second race, and lasted all the rest of the afternoon, made the track fetid-deep in water, owing to the storm being so heavy it was impossible to take the time of the third horse, as the start was made in the mud.
