COAL BEING SEIZED

Hundreds of Carloads in Transit Taken Over by the Authorities.

Reports from various railroad centres showed that seizure of coal in transit, as ordered by the Federal Government, had begun. Hundreds of coal-laden cars in transit were taken over by regional directors of the fuel administration and were side-tracked to await possible distribution under the administration's priority schedule.

SARNIA, Nov. 2.—That the strike of bituminous coal workers in the United States will have little effect on the local coal situation, with the exception of a probable increase in prices, is intimated by local dealers. J. C. Clark of the Clark Milk Company, stated that this district was chiefly an anthracite centre, and that the majority of factories were using natural gas in their furnaces. Manufacturers using coal have a fairly large supply on hand, and no difficulty is anticipated in operating.
