In conclusion, your Committee feel deeply impressed with the great importance of Sunday School work, they believe that it is a work which, in these days, the Church cannot afford to neglect. Much of the future growth and success of the Church depends, under God's blessing, on the instruction given to the young, and that instruction should therefore be of the best. Your Committee would therefore urge upon the Synod the importance of giving the Sunday School due prominence in its deliberations.
