

## PARIS HOUSES PRETENDER TO CAZAR'S THRONE

Grand Duke Nicholas  
Called On To  
Fight

"Head of Older French Family,"  
Royalist Leader, Forced  
To Exile

PARIS, April 7.—Paris awoke this morning to find that it had two pretenders to thrones. One of them is the Duke of Guise, aspirant for the throne of the French Royalists, beginning the eighth century. The other is Grand Duke Nicholas Nicolaievich, who has been requested by a congress of Russian monarchists to fight for the throne of the Czar in Russia.

Under the law voted in 1886, the Duke of Guise, who has announced that he will replace the late Duke of Orleans as head of the French Royalists and as "pretender" to the French throne, is doomed to exile. By strange irony of fate, Grand Duke Nicholas

on the other hand, will be able to live in intrigue at his chateau near Paris, while the head of "The oldest French family" is denied all the rights of his native soil.

### SEE TROUBLE AHEAD

This anomalous situation is certain to have a repercussion in the Chamber of Deputies and the Senate when they reconvene for, while French Royalists now are few in parliament, the Socialists and the Communists are bound to stir up trouble and demand that the government no longer harbor Nicholas—provided he accepts the leadership in the Russian restoration movement. Besides the Soviet embassy in Paris is almost certain to have a word to say.

All partisanship aside, general regret is expressed that an unassuming gentleman like the Duke of Guise, through accident of birth, is forced to exile himself and his young son. The Duke has arrived in Naples. It is understood he will divide his time between Palermo and his estate near Brussels.

## CONGREGATIONS IN CHATHAM JOIN ALSO UNDER ONE HEAD

St. Luke's

CHATHAM, April 6.—Union of the Church of St. Andrew and St. John and of St. Luke's church was decided upon at meetings of the two congregations held last night. The vote in each instance was unanimous for union. The meeting of the congregation of the Church of St. Andrew and St. John was presided over by A. G. Dickson with R. A. Walls as secretary.

After the result of the vote had been announced a resolution was adopted calling upon the Presbytery of the Miramichi to proceed to the consummation of the union of the two congregations into one congregation of the United Church of Canada. The congregations were then addressed by their pastor.

### ALSO UNANIMOUS.

At the meeting of the St. Luke's congregation the pastor, Rev. George M. Young, acted as chairman and C. H. Harrison as secretary. The vote was 103 to 0 in favor of union. A similar resolution was adopted asking that the presbytery confirm the union of the two congregations. The congregations for the present will be known as the United Church of Chatham.

### PASTORS RESIGN.

All details of the union have been left to committees. The two pastors will remain here until the end of June. As each has handed in his resignation at that time a call will be extended by the united congregations.
