REPORT IRISH MIRACLES

Cures Said to Have Been Worked Before
Bleeding Statures.

Belfast, Aug. 25.—Intense excitement prevails in Templemore, County Tipperary, the scene of the recent murder of Police Inspector Wilson, over what are reported to be remarkable manifestations of healing.

The Churles correspond of a local newspaper sends details of what he describes as a "miracle," which he says began yesterday evening and still continues.

"About six o'clock," he says, "all the statues and holy pictures in the house of Thomas Divan, a news agent, began to bleed. Crowds of awed people witnessed the strange manifestation, and wonderful cures are being effected.

"A crippled soldier, who was carried down to Divan's on crutches, with a leg which had been badly shattered by shrapnel in France, walked back from the house with full use of his limbs. He had been three years in a hospital. A little girl, a victim of consumption, was borne into the house, and she, too, was cured.

"People are thronging to Templemore to see the cures, news of which are being discussed throughout Tipperary."



28 STOWAWAYS ON BOARD SHIP

Vessel Had Crew of Twenty-Two — After Being Jailed the 28 Broke Out.

New York, Aug. 25.—Captain Pericles of the Portuguese steamer Morning discovered after he had been at sea some days that there were 28 stowaways on board. His crew is only 22. He touched at New Bedford, where the 28 were jailed.

The stowaways waited until the jailer had gone to bed. Then one among them produced a button-hook, unlocked the jail door, and the 28 departed, leaving the jail intact.

The next morning the citizens of New Bedford, who don't get a chance every day to see 28 stowaways, arrived early at the jail only to find the cage empty. Greatly disappointed, they "razed" the police chief until he became indignant, and arrested the officers on the ship, charging them with complicity in the escape. But there was no proof against them, so they were released.

TO INCREASE COTTON CULTIVATION IN BRAZIL
Rio De Janeiro, Aug. 24.—Increased and improved production of cotton, especially in northeastern Brazil, which is at present quite undeveloped, is the object of a Cotton Service Bureau recently established by presidential decree.

The bureau will investigate the properties of the soil and climatic conditions, and establish experimental stations to study the culture of cotton and prevent diseases. Planters in the cotton zones will be provided with machinery. Implements and fertilizers at post prices, and establishments will be installed for preparing cotton for market.

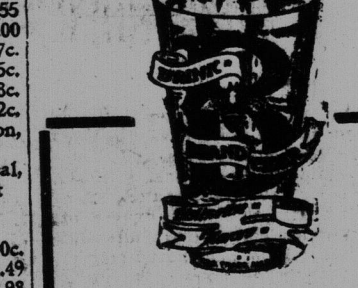
