## GETS WARM IN ONTARIO POLITICS

### CANADIANS PROMINENT AT GENEVA

Geneva, Sept. 6.—Hon. W. S. Fielding, chairman of the Canadian delegation, was elected yesterday as chairman of the committee on social and general questions before the assembly. He is also a member of the committee on reduction of armaments.

Ernest Lapointe and P. C. Larkin, also of the Canadian delegation, are on the committee on constitutional and political questions and technical organization and finance, respectively. The Canadians have been very active since the opening of the assembly, taking part in numerous conferences with their colleagues. It has not yet been decided whether the delegation will urge the adoption of former Minister of Justice Doherty's amendment eliminating article 10 from the covenant.

W. Brock Allen, a C. N. R. conductor, and his mother, Mrs. Alonso Barker, were seriously injured last night, when their automobile overturned in the Woodstock road. Both are in the Fredrickton hospital.

The by-election for the constituencies of southeast Toronto and Russell have been fixed for October 23, when representatives to the Ontario parliament are to be selected.

Cotton operatives in Maine are demanding an increase in wages. It is estimated that 20,000 people will be affected by the proposed schedule.
