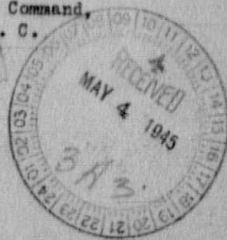

1. This soldier was one of a number of SUS selected for o/s, their sentences to be remitted on the day following embarkation.
2. On 22 Mar 45, which was the day previous to despatch, the accused succeeded in escaping from the detention barracks, obviously to avoid the draft. He was re-arrested on 26 Mar 45 and has since been Pulhemized S5, and is to be discharged from the Army. This HQ is of the opinion that this soldier should continue to serve the sentence of one years detention awarded by DCM 11 Dec 44.
