

request that the Stipendiary Magistrate be instructed to at once dispense with the services of this Constable, who instead of assisting to enforce the law is advising the Indians to break it.

With regard to the request made by the Indians through Mr Loring to be allowed to retain the custom of Potlaching for a year or so more, and the hope expressed by Mr Loring that the Dept't will be lenient for the present as the custom has the tendency to die out in the course of two or three years, the undersigned begs to state that, as to the Dept't allowing the Indians to retain the custom, it is quite out of the question.
