And General Expression That It Should be Retired

WAS SENSE OF THE MEETING

But Just How Tco Best Accomplish Desired Results is Still an **Open Question.**

The Board of Trade held a special necting Saturday night for the consideration of /the question of gold dust as a circulating medium. There were about 25 of the representative business men present and after a two-hours' discussion the following resolution was adopted :

It is the opinion of the Board of Trade that lawful movey of Canada be the only medium of exchange in Daw-son and that the chairman appoint a committee of five within three days to confer with miners and merchants as to the best time to enforce the retirement of gold dust committee to report within two weeks to a special meeting called for the purpose of receiving the report.
