23d. On the twenty-third, as I hinted above, we began to move forward, and to Chape our courfe nearly North; but the weather was in general fo hot, and fo mexh frow had, in confequence, been metted, as made it bad walking in fnow-fhoes, and fuct exceding heavy hauling, that it was the third of May before we could arrive at Clowey, though the diftafice was not above eighty-five friles from Thelewey-aza-yeth. In our way we cfoffed part of two fmall Lakes, called Tittameg Lake and Seartack Lake; neither of which are of any note, though both abound with fine fifh.
