## BILL.

An Act to incorporate *La Communauté des Révérendes Sœurs de la Charite*, of Bytown.

**W**HEREAS an Association hath existed Preamble.  
for several years at Bytown, in Upper  
Canada, under the name of *La Communauté  
des Révérendes Sœurs de la Charité*, and  
5 hath established an Hospital for the recep-  
tion and care of indigent and infirm sick per-  
sons of both sexes, and of orphans of both  
sexes, to whom they impart a Christian  
education in conformity with their condition  
10 in life: And whereas, the said Ladies have  
by their Petition prayed that the said Associa-  
tion may be incorporated, and in considera-  
tion of the great benefits which must arise  
from the said Institution, it is expedient to  
15 grant their prayer: Be it enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of  
the same, That *Les Révérendes Sœurs* Eliza-  
beth Bruyère, Eléonore Thibodeau, Marie  
Ursule Cécile Charlebois *dite* St. Joseph;  
20 Hélène Antoinette Howard *dite* Rodriguez,  
Patronille Clément *dite* Xavier, Marguerite  
Rivais, Marie Anne Joséphine Jones *dite* St.  
Pierre, Marthe Hogan, Adélaïde Pageau  
*dite* St. Croix, Marie Curran *dite* Youville,  
25 Mary Phelan, Eléonore Lavoie, Esther Ca-  
dieux *dite* Normand, Rose Leblanc and Léo-  
cadie Dubé, and such other persons as shall,  
under the provisions of this Act, become  
members of the said Institution, shall be and  
30 are hereby declared to be a body politic and  
corporate, in deed and in name, by the name  
of *La Communauté des Révérendes Sœurs de  
la Charité*, and by that name shall have per-
