## BILL.

An Act to incorporate La Communauté des Révérendes Sœurs de la Charite, of Bytown.

WHEREAS an Association hath existed Preamble. for several years at Bytown, in Upper Canada, under the name of La Communauté des Révérendes Sœurs de la Charité, and 5 hath established an Hospital for the reception and care of indigent and infirm sick persons of both sexes, and of orphans of both sexes, to whom they impart a Christian education in conformity with their condition 10 in life: And whereas, the said Ladies have by their Petition prayed that the said Association may be incorporated, and in consideration of the great benefits which must arise from the said Institution, it is expedient to 15 grant their prayer: Be it enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Les Révérendes Sœurs Elizabeth Bruyère, Eléonore Thibodeau, Marie Ursule Cécile Charlebois dite St. Joseph; 20 Hélène Antoinette Howard dite Rodriguez, Patronille Clément dite Xavier, Marguerite Rivais, Marie Anne Joséphine Jones dite St. Pierre, Marthe Hogan, Adélaide Pageau dite St. Croix, Marie Curran dite Youville. 25 Mary Phelan, Eléonore Lavoie, Esther Cadieux dite Normand, Rose Leblanc and Léocadie Dubé, and such other persons as shall, under the provisions of this Act, become members of the said Institution, shall be and 30 are hereby declared to be a body politic and corporate, in deed and in name, by the name of La Communauté des Révèrendes Sœurs de la Charité, and by that name shall have per-
