Incorporated Company as to him may appear expedient for the protection of the interests of the Crown, or of parties to legal proceedings, as aforesaid.

Liatility of Companies issuing policics. 5. The Incorporated Companies by whom any such bond or policy of guarantce shall be given or granted, shall be liable to indemnify 5 as well the Crown as the party or parties to any legal proceedings, for any loss or damage arising out of any omission, default or misconduct of the said Sheriff, and all the provisions of the said Act, with respect to the examination of the said bond and duplicate covenant, by parties interested, the liability to indemnify parties 10 sustaining damage and proceedings in actions upon the bond or covenant contained in the seventeenth, eighteenth, nineteenth, twentieth, twenty-first and twenty-second sections of the said Act, respecting the office of Sheriff, shall apply to and have force and effect in respect of such bonds or policies of guarantee in the same 15 manner and as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as though the said bonds and policies had been expressly mentioned therein.
